- Choose a local band plan source
- Choose a frequency band 2m, 70 cm
- Select the chart to view
- Determine your usage and radio capability, i.e. FM, simplex, repeater, SSB, Packet
- Select from the frequencies recommended



### **Understanding the Plans**

- SMC Sheriff's are for local city frequency recommendations (within SM County)
- ARRL charts are general and for the US
- Local councils (NARCC) have local state usage recommendations
- If you travel other areas may have other recommendations (So Ca repeaters are different from No Cal)



#### US Amateur Radio Bands






### NARCC 70 cm Band Plan

70 cm Band Plan for Northern California 420.0 - 450.0 MHz



25 kHz channel spacing 440.0 - 450.0 MHz

Links, Auxiliary, and digital are 20 kHz wide channels except as noted ATV is a single 6 MHz wide simplex channel

Weak Signal, Satellite, and All Mode segments are not channelized



### Review of the 2m band

- From the NARCC and NCPA charts:
- There are established frequencies for simplex and repeater usage
- Nets with sub frequencies should choose frequencies in another different segment to avoid cross-talk
- Use both VHF and UHF frequencies to avoid crosstalk
- Choose frequencies compatible with local customs



### The 70 cm Band

- There are only three simplex channels
- There are MANY UHF repeater channels
